

Pupil safety is of the utmost importance to us both within our school and around our school grounds. As a Rights Respecting School, we recognise the right for children to be safe (Articles 6 & 19) and our responsibility as adults to act in the best interests of every child (Article 3).

## Please remind yourself of the Road Safety Rules at Lough View to keep all our children safe!

- 1. Please obey the one-way traffic system at all times and follow the 5 mph speed limit at all times.
- 2. DO NOT cross the one-way system and park on the other side of the driveway facing on-coming traffic, as this has an impact on, and slows down the flow, of exiting traffic.
- 3. DO NOT park your car on the main driveway, if it is not in an allocated space, or
- 4. DO NOT mount the pavement, especially outside the KS2 gate, as this creates a serious hazard for the other road users and children at the crossing.
- 5. Do not walk children across turning circle. Please use the footpath provided.
- 6. No mobile phones should be used when driving on school grounds.
- 7. Please drive with patience and consideration for others.
- 8. In the morning **drop off bays** are for drop off. Please do not use these if you wish to park and accompany your children into school.
- 9. In the afternoon DO NOT park in the bus parking area which is clearly marked.
- 10. Please leave the site promptly after pick up so that you free up spaces for others.
- 11. The image below outlines clearly where you should not park at any time.
